WHAT ROLE DOES SELF LOVE PLAY OUT IN THIS GENERATION?

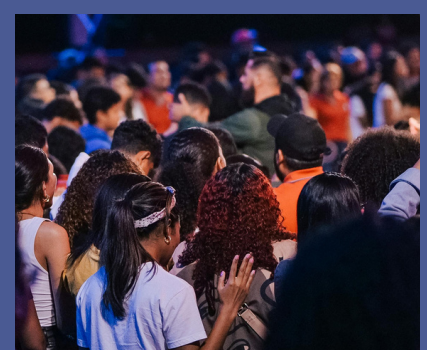
