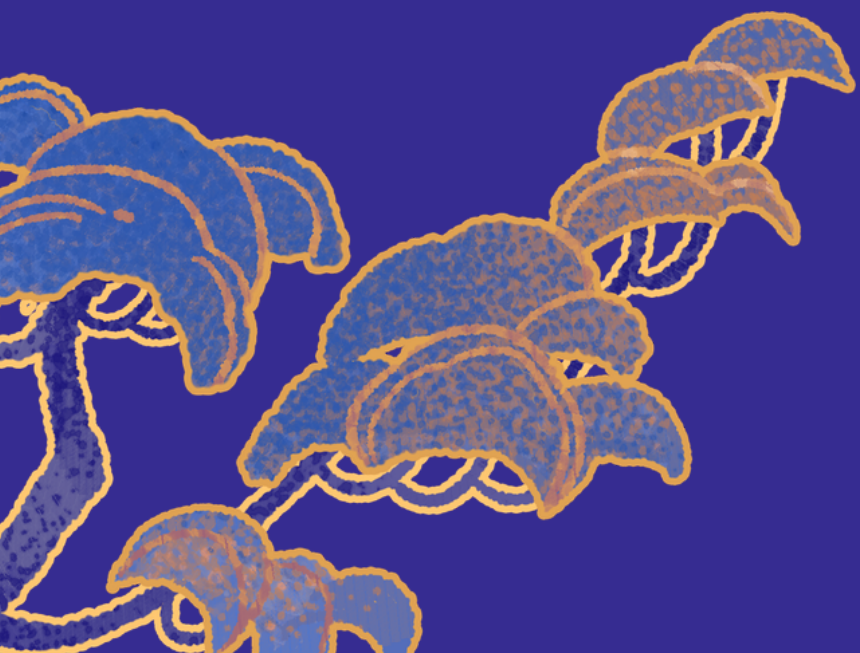
How do you Thank God?

In my book, "True Worshipers" I speak about the many reasons why God is to be worshipped. The

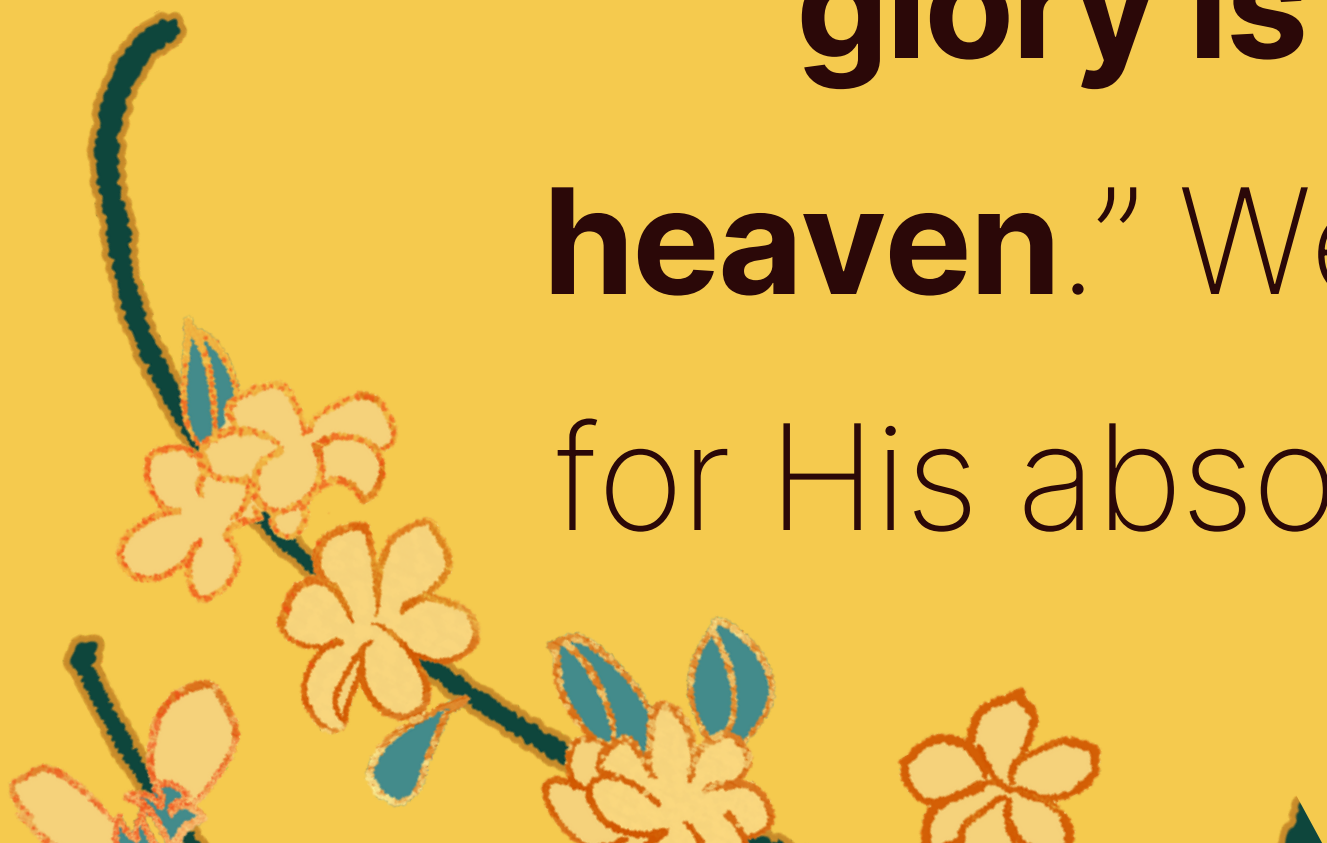

Where are we to praise God?

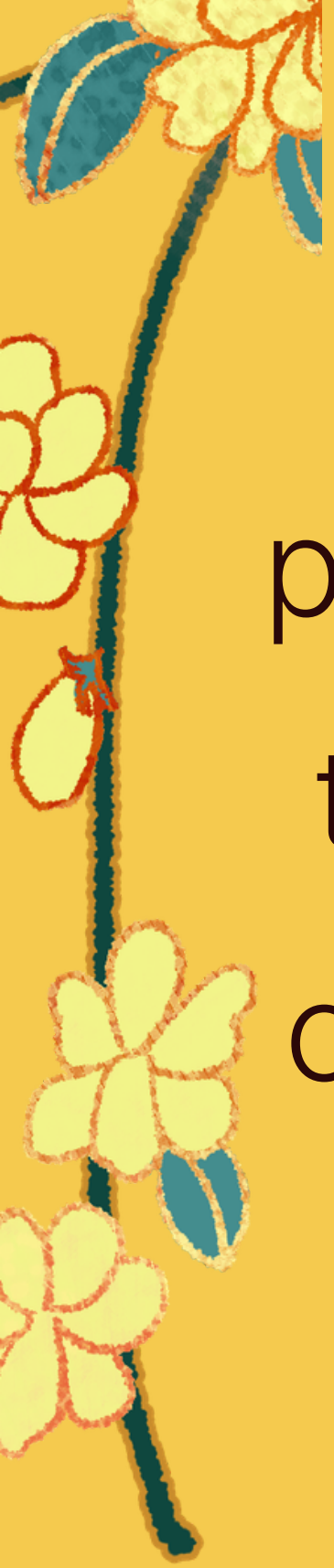

congregation.”**

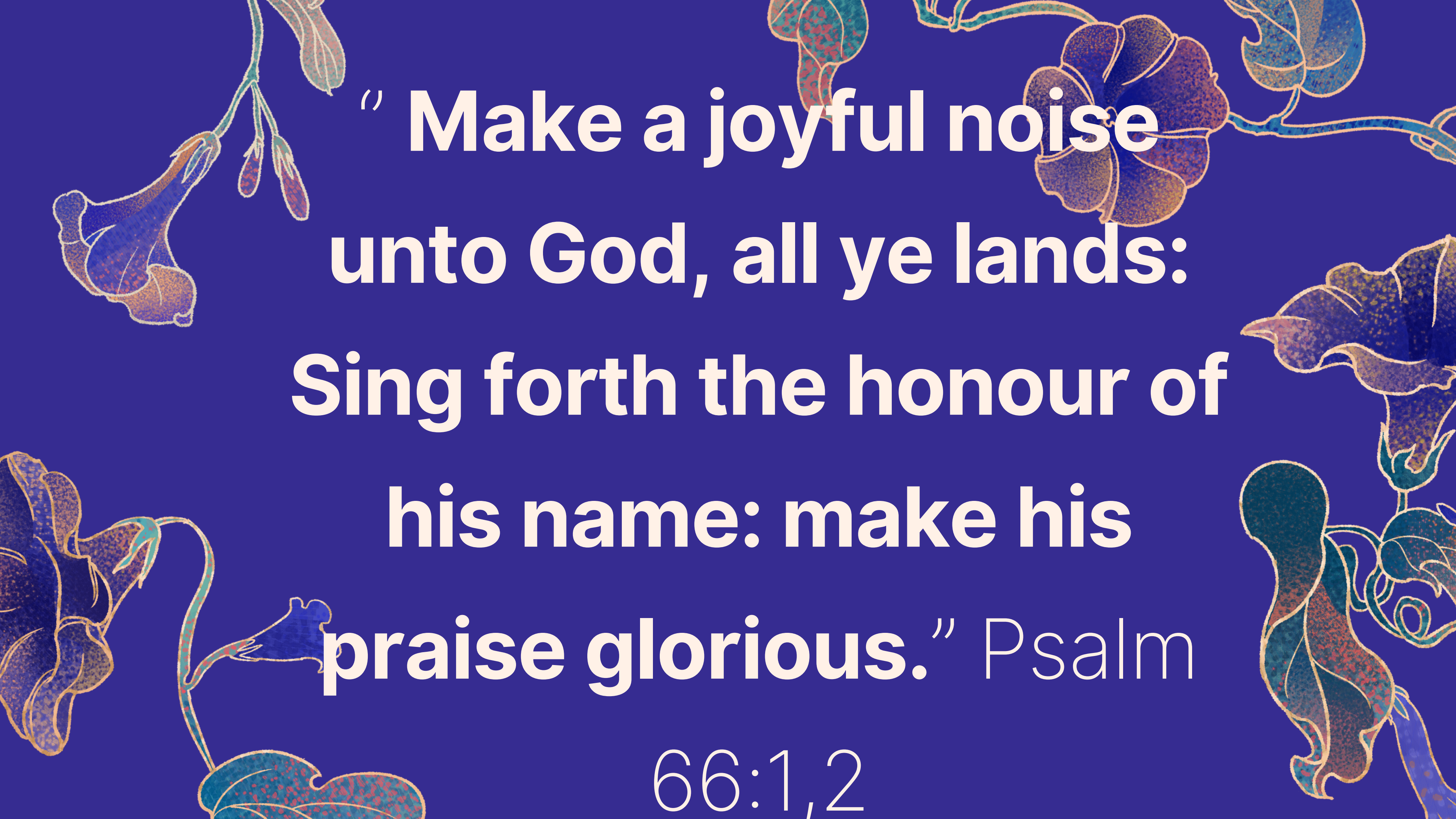

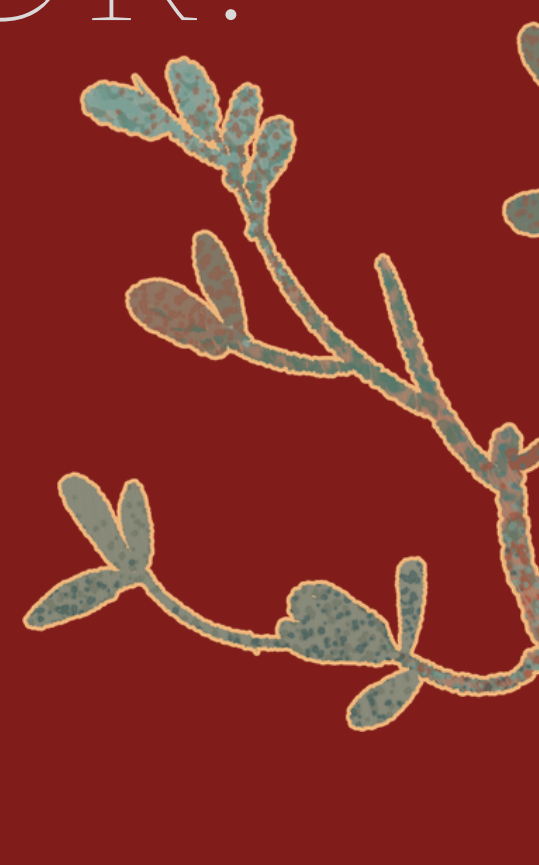

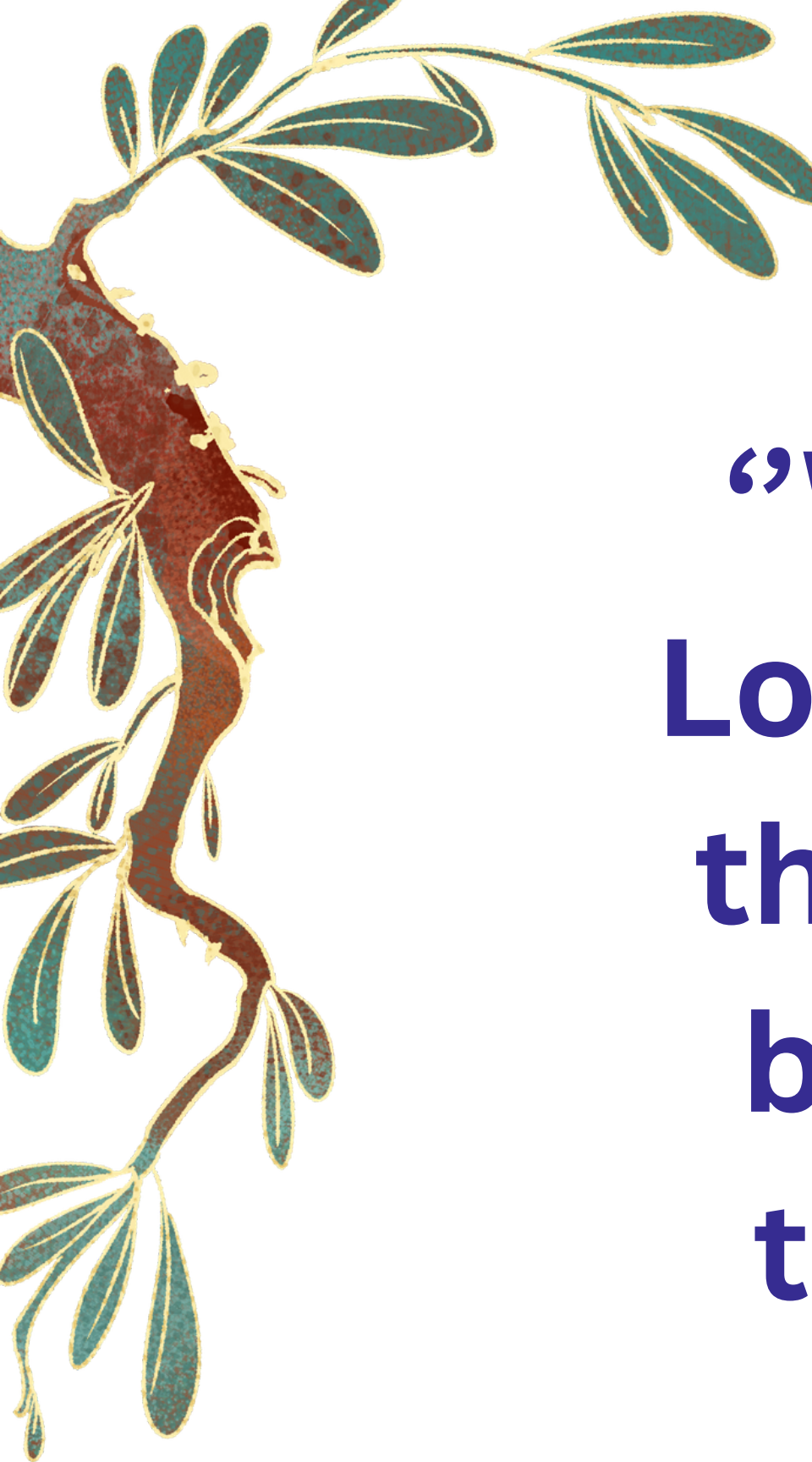
